**UNOPPOSED MOTION OF THE
UNITED STATES TO INTERVENE**

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2403(a), the United States respectfully moves to intervene in this appeal.

“In any action . . . in a court of the United States to which the United States . . . is not a party, wherein the constitutionality of any Act of Congress affecting the public interest is drawn into question, the court shall certify such fact to the Attorney General, and shall permit the United States to intervene . . . for argument on the question of constitutionality.” *See* 28 U.S.C. § 2403(a). Appellant notified the Court that the above-captioned appeal “question[s] the constitutionality of an Act of Congress.” *See* Fed. R. App. P. 44(a). In an order issued on August 28, 2018, the Court certified the fact of appellant’s constitutional challenge to the Attorney General and directed the Attorney

General to notify the Court within 30 days whether the United States intends to intervene.

The United States hereby moves to exercise its statutory right to intervene in this appeal under 28 U.S.C. § 2403(a) to defend the constitutionality of the Act of Congress that appellant challenges. Counsel for appellant does not oppose this motion.
