ORDER

The Court held a telephonic status conference on June 10, 2019, at joint request of the parties. (ECF No. 254). In light of the parties' positions as presented in their Joint Motion (ECF No. 254) and during the telephonic status conference, the Court hereby GRANTS IN PART and DENIES IN PART the relief sought by each party in the Joint Motion (ECF No. 254) as follows.


It is hereby ORDERED that all pending proceedings, motions, deadlines, and obligations to engage in discovery are held in abeyance, with the following exceptions:

1. On or before June 21, 2019, Plaintiffs shall either file a supplemental brief pursuant to the provisions in the Court's Order at ECF No. 245, or Plaintiffs shall file a Notice on the docket indicating that they will not file such a supplemental brief. If Plaintiffs timely file such a supplemental brief, Defendants may file a response to such brief pursuant to the provisions in the Court's Order at ECF No. 245.
2. The parties shall promptly confer and file a joint status report if the Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit issues a decision regarding the pending petition for rehearing *en banc* in *Amgen Inc. v. Sandoz Inc.*, Nos. 18-1551, 18-1552 (Fed. Cir. May 8,

2019), or a decision regarding the pending appeal in *Amgen Inc. v. Coherus BioSciences, Inc.*, No. 18-1993 (Fed. Cir. filed May 21, 2018).

3. The parties shall file a joint status report on or before July 8, 2019, including as to all relevant proceedings before the Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit.

The abeyance described in this Order shall remain in place pending further Order of the Court, to be issued on or around July 15, 2019. It may be lifted prior to July 15, 2019, or extended past July 15, 2019, on motion by either party or *sua sponte* by the Court for good cause shown.
