ORDER

On June 13, 2019, the Court ordered that all pending proceedings, motions, deadlines, and obligations to engage in discovery were to be held in abeyance, with limited exceptions as described in the Court's Order of that date. (ECF No. 264). The abeyance was to remain in place pending further Order of the Court, to be issued on or around July 15, 2019. (*Id.*).

As directed by that Order, the parties submitted a Joint Status Report on July 8, 2019. (ECF No. 272). In light of the procedural posture of relevant cases before the Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit, as outlined in the Joint Status Report at ECF No. 272, and the parties' positions as presented during the telephonic status conference held on June 10, 2019, (ECF No. 263), and in the parties' Joint Motion for a Status Conference at ECF No. 254, the Court concludes that good cause exists to extend the abeyance imposed by the Order at ECF No. 264.

It is hereby ORDERED that the abeyance imposed by the Order at ECF No. 264 shall remain in place pending further Order of the Court, to be issued on or around August 14, 2019. It may be lifted prior to August 14, 2019, or extended past August 14, 2019, on motion by either party or *sua sponte* by the Court for good cause shown.

Notwithstanding the abeyance, it is further ORDERED that:

1. The parties shall promptly confer and file a joint status report if the Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit issues a decision regarding the pending appeal in *Amgen Inc. v. Coherus BioSciences, Inc.*, No. 18-1993 (Fed. Cir. filed May 21, 2018). The parties shall also promptly confer and file a joint status report if there are any significant developments regarding Amgen's pending petition for rehearing *en banc* in *Amgen Inc. v. Sandoz Inc.*, Nos. 18-1551, 18-1552 (Fed. Cir. May 8, 2019).

2. The parties shall file a joint status report on or before August 7, 2019, including as to all relevant proceedings before the Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit.
